Faith Formation Curriculums:

Pre-School (Ages 3 & 4): Allelu by Our Sunday Visitor



"Growing and Celebrating with Jesus"- Allelu is a Christ-centered early childhood program that uses unique, multi-sensory learning techniques to engage the children in learning about the life and teachings of Jesus Christ and the Catholic Faith. Each Sunday, the children will bring home a child/ family activity sheet that is designed like a placemat for the dinner table. It includes a note for parents/guardians on what your child learned and some activities to reinforce the lesson at home throughout the week.

Elementary: Pflaum Gospel Weeklies, Grades K-5



The Pflaum Gospel Weeklies Curriculum connects catechetical lessons to Sunday Mass with the Sunday Gospel being the heart of each lesson. Each student will receive a lesson booklet, that is different each week, and a catechism handbook that are both at age appropriate levels. The catechism handbook is titled, "What the Church Believes and Teaches." The titles of the booklets are as follows:

Grades K-1: *Promise* Grades 2-3: *Good News* Grades 4-5: *Venture*

Faith Formation Curriculums: Middle School: Edge from Lifeteen, Grades 6, 7, 8



The goal of this program for middle-school youth is to lead them closer to Jesus Christ and the Church while growing their understanding and knowledge of their Catholic Faith. The sessions are done in a Youth Group format with semester themes and engaging, relevant topics.

High School (Grade 9): Chosen: This is Your Catholic Faith by Ascension Press



This program takes teens on a journey through their entire Catholic Faith. The lessons are structured through DVD (presentations are done by 12 top youth experts in the Church today), workbook and classroom discussions. This is a perfect pre-Confirmation curriculum leading up to the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.


High School (Grade 10): Decision Point - Part One by Dynamic Catholic



Decision Point begins the path towards the Sacrament of Confirmation. The first part of the school year, lessons are covered from part of the curriculum. In January, the second part is covered in the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The format is DVD presentations by Matthew Kelly, author, founder of Dynamic Catholic and renowned international speaker, followed by group discussions

Family Life Curriculums:

Grades K-8 - Benzinger Family Life Series



As part of the elementary and middle school curriculum and as required by the Archdiocese of Baltimore, the Benzinger Family Life Series is used in our program. The sessions are covered during the months of January and February. This series focuses on God's gifts of family, self, life, love and community. Child protection is also covered and discussed in age appropriate manners. In grades five and six, the human reproduction segment is sent home to the parent/guardian.

High School - Created to Love



As part of the high school curriculum and as required by the Archdiocese of Baltimore, the Created to Love series is used in our program. This program focuses on healthy relationships and an understanding of the need of a family environment of love, virtue and respect for the gifts of God. Child protection is also covered and discussed in an age appropriate manner. The Created to Love course is taught every two years either in two class sessions or four class sessions.

Worthy of the Call: Youth Volunteer and Child Protection Training, Ages 14-18

This video-assisted, discussion training, developed by the Archdiocese of Baltimore, is required for all youth, ages 14-18, before volunteering or serving in the Church. The goals of this program are to help keep our youth safe and help them engage in healthy, and meaningful ministry in the Church. This program is incorporated into the High School Curriculum.

Arrival:

PLEASE NOTE:

9:00 a.m. Mass dismissal will be occurring between 10:00 a.m. and 10:15 a.m. Please be mindful of pedestrian traffic and follow the oneway entrance to St. Mary Church parking lot from A Street, and the one-way exit onto Grand Avenue.



For teens and older children, you may pull up to the sidewalk, directly behind the Faith Formation Center and the Office Center, on Prince Georges Street. There is a gate that leads to steps and a ramp behind the building. They can take those and come around to the front entrances.

Dismissal:

Faith Formation dismissal time is 11:30 a.m. Please abide by the following:

For Pre-school to Grade 5, please come into the Office Center building or Faith Formation Center to the classroom to get your child/children.

Pre-school to Grade 5, cont.:

Catechists will not let the child leave until a parent/guardian or appropriate person is present (Those listed on the Faith Formation registration form).

For Grades 6 to High School, they may meet you in the parking lot. If you would like your child/children dismissed in another way, please put that in writing and give to your child's teacher.



Handicap Access:

Security/Locked Doors:

Cell phones should not be used for personal use during class time. They may be used, at the discretion of the catechist, for class purposes, for example, apps, for the curriculum or class activities.

Texting will be used, through Flocknote, for group and important information. The Faith Formation and Sacramental information in the parish bulletin and on the parish website will be updated weekly.
